About Telangana Yuvathi Mandali:

The Telangana Yuvathi Mandali (TYM) is one of the oldest Not for Profit supporting women in the country. It was established in the year 1935 in the then Princely State of Hyderabad. It was originally called 'Andhra Yuvathi Mandali' for identifying the Telugu speaking populace in the region. After the formation of the Telangana State in 2014, it was renamed as the Telangana Yuvathi Mandali. The Institution has been, over the years, rendering various services for the upliftment of women. The Burgula Ramakrishna Rao (BRR) Girls' High School which is being run by Telangana Yuvathi Mandali, has completed more than 60 years in the service of basic education of the girl child. Over the years, the Mandali has also started an Intermediate College in 1994, a degree College in 1995 and an MBA program in 2008. All these Institutions are run on a non-profit basis by the Mandali.



About the Program

Sonata, as part of its CSR engagement is supporting Telangana Yuvathi Mandali by funding a Grant of Rs.5,00,000/- per annum under the 3 years program starting from the year 2018-19. This grant is sanctioned to offer quality education at an affordable price to the girl child.

Expected Outcome

The said Grants will be used for enhancing the paying capacity, to get better teachers and their staff benefits and building infrastructure for enhancing student learning experience for the girl child . This in turn helps encourage Girls who are from economically challenged families and first-generation aspirants to join the school and bring down the drop out levels by offering a low fee structure with good teaching and extracurricular activities.
